



U.S. Commercial Service Presents **SELECTUSA ROAD SHOW IN INDIA**

The SelectUSA teams of the Department of Commerce in Washington, D.C. and India are organizing a SelectUSA Road Show in three cities: Mumbai, Bangalore and New Delhi. The purpose of the Road Show is to create a platform for U.S. state governments to present their priority projects directly to interested Indian companies to raise overall awareness in India about the opportunities to invest in the United States.

Road Show Description

The Road Show will help participating firms gain market insights, learn of the existing investment opportunities, make industry and state government contacts, solidify business strategies, and advance specific projects, with the goal of increasing inbound investment into the U.S. The Road Show will include one-on-one business appointments for state delegates with firms who have already expressed interest in the specific sector or specific investment and networking events. The Road Show will bring together the American marketplace and Indian cash-rich companies.

- Recent data released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) shows that since January 2012, a total of \$8.25 billion has been invested by Indian companies as outbound FDI.
- JSW Steel invested \$65.46 million in the US which is involved manufacturing.
- The Sahara Group has agreed to buy a controlling stake in New York's landmark Plaza Hotel for \$570 million.
- Reliance India Limited (RIL), Oil & Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) and Gas Authority of India (GAIL) interested in shares of LNG terminals on the east coast of the USA.
